5 INGREDIENT WHITE QUESO

1 lb pepperjack cheese 3/4 cup whole milk
8 oz full-fat sour cream 1 can Rotel, drained
8 oz full-fat cream cheese

In a slow-cooker or medium pot, combine the cheese, cream cheese, sour cream, Rotel, and about half of the milk.

Turn heat onto low, and let the mixture heat until the cheeses melt and a smooth cream forms, stirring occasionally. Add more milk as needed.

FUN FACTS ABOUT FALL



- The first day of autumn falls on September 22nd this year and is known as the autumnal equinox. On this day, the number of hours of daylight and darkness are equal.

- Yellow, orange and variations thereof always reside in the pigmentation of tree leaves, but they are overpowered by the abundance of green from the chlorophyll in the leaves. Come autumn, when the sun weakens and days grow shorter, the amount of chlorophyll in leaves diminishes, allowing the other pigments in the leaves to show through.

- Evergreen trees will not lose their leaves like deciduous trees. Their leaves, also called needles, are covered with a thick wax. This wax protects the inner components of the needles, preventing them from freezing.
